Keep the Horton General board their battle bus once again for a trip to Oxford on Saturday 19th November.

Armed with leaflets detailing how removal of services at the Horton General Hospital will affect all communities in Oxfordshire, KTHG will be in Oxford city centre 10.00 - 14.30.

We will also be distributing a sheet on key 'Sustainability and Transformation Plan' (STP) facts. This is a surreptitious process that has received remarkably little publicity despite potentially changing our National Health Service for ever.

'The purpose of our event is two pronged' said KTHG Chairman, Keith Strangwood. 'We will be informing the public about the damage that is being inflicted on local services by the Oxford University Hospitals Foundation Trust and Oxfordshire Clinical Commissioning Group. Simultaneously the NHS nationally is being threatened by Simon Stevens' draconian proposals, via STP, for swingeing cuts across the board. We are very fortunate to have supporters who care not only about their local hospital but hospitals across the land.
